

# Italy. The Italian Sea Group -ferry ship RFI leaves Nuovi Cantieri Apuania

Wednesday, 27 March 2013

On 29th March 2013 the ferry ship "Messina" of Rete Ferroviaria Italiana (Gruppo Ferrovie dello Stato Italiane) will leave the Nuovi Cantieri Apuania yard (today belonging, with the yachting brand Admiral Tecnomar, to the conglomerate The Italian sea Group).

The Ferry ship will operate on the strait of Messina route to transfer the railway carriages and coaches. The bow opens to allow an easy access and exit to the coaches.

The ship has a length of 147meters, a beam of 18,7 meters and a speed of 18kn.

The ferry ship has also high manoeuvrability, thanks to the installation of 3 azimuth thrusters at stern, 2 bow thrusters and 1 rudder.
